A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL, CALIFORNIA REQUESTING PARTICIPATION IN THE ORANGELINE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (OLDA)

WHEREAS, the City finds in its interest to continue to pursue an environmentally friendly transit system in the City of Bell; and

WHEREAS, participation as an OLDA member increases the chances of our being successful in the development of this transit system by participating with other cities along the OLDA corridor between Sana Ana and Santa Clarita; and


WHEREAS, it is important for all the cities in the Authority to be active participants in the decision making process for OLDA; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE:


1. Request a one-time waiver of the OLDA membership fee for the 2011/12 fiscal year so that participation can continue in the development of this very important transit service for our residents.




