

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-03

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BELL CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING THE CITY'S COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014-2015**

WHEREAS, on August 22, 1974, the President of the United States signed into law the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Act); and

WHEREAS, the primary goals of Title I of the Act are the development of viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bell has received notification of the availability of new Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$451,676; and

WHEREAS, staff estimates that an additional \$227,124 in 2013-2014 unexpended funds will be available for a total of \$678,800 to further the attainment of these goals during Fiscal Year 2014-2015; and

WHEREAS, The City of Bell passed Resolution No. 2014-03 on January 22, 2014 approving the FY 2014-15 CDBG program and budget allocation in the amount of \$678,800 which included funding for lead based paint/testing, handyworker program, rehabilitation program, code compliance, graffiti removal program, sidewalk and curb project, and facilities improvement program as indicated in the Agenda Report; and

WHEREAS, the City has posted information regarding eligible activities under the Act and has conducted a public hearing to solicit comments and suggestions from the community for the utilization of these funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City Manager and/or his designee are authorized and directed to submit the projects and programs for the City's Planning Summary for Fiscal Year 2014-2015.

Section 2. That the City Manager and/or his designee are authorized to adjust the program budget as necessary to take into account the final CDBG allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and any amounts remaining unspent at the close of the fiscal year.

Section 3. That the City Manager and/or his designee are authorized to execute the contractual and related documents to be prepared by the County of Los Angeles that are required for the implementation of the projects/ programs set forth herein.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and adoption.


