

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-53

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BELL, CALIFORNIA, SUPPORTING CALIFORNIA
PROPOSITION 1, WATER BOND (2014)**

WHEREAS, the California legislature passed Assembly Bill 1471 on August 13, 2014;
and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1471 was signed by Governor Jerry Brown on August 13,
2014; and

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 1471 places a \$7.12 Billion Water Bond (Proposition 1) on the
November 4, 2014 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the Water Bond, if approved by California voters, will provide funding for a
variety of projects for greater water use efficiency, water recycling, groundwater cleanup and
management, water storage, safeguarding drinking water in disadvantaged communities,
watershed restoration, and improving water flows of rivers and streams; and

WHEREAS, the Water Bond, if approved by California voters, will provide funding for the
San Gabriel and Lower Los Angeles Rivers and Mountains Conservancy (RMC) which includes
the City of Bell; and


WHEREAS, the City of Bell will have opportunities to apply for grants through the RMC if
the Water Bond is approved by voters; and

WHEREAS, California in general will greatly benefit from projects funded by the Water
Bond, which have become even more urgent given the State's severe drought.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL DOES RESOLVE
AS FOLLOWS:**

The Water Bond will provide many grant opportunities for a variety of water improvement
projects for the City of Bell, and funding for many urgently needed projects statewide to ensure
safe and stable sources of water for all Californians. Therefore, the City of Bell urges California
voters to approve Proposition 1, Water Bond on November 4, 2014.




