

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-58

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, POLICE CHIEF, AND CITY ATTORNEY TO COORDINATE WITH AN ANONYMOUS DONOR AND FACILITATE AN UNCONDITIONAL GIFT OF THREE NEW POLICE VEHICLES TO THE CITY AT NO COST TO THE CITY

Recitals

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Government Code section 37354, the City of Bell ("City") is authorized to accept gifts of real and personal property for any public purpose; and

WHEREAS, an anonymous donor has offered to purchase three new police vehicles and donate them as unconditional gifts to the City at no cost; and

WHEREAS, two of three vehicles will be completely outfitted as Sergeant Command Vehicles with advanced communications and monitoring equipment to better serve the community during critical incidents; and

WHEREAS, before the donor purchases the vehicles, the donor wants to ensure that the City will accept them; and


WHEREAS, the City Council greatly appreciates the generosity of the donor as the police vehicles will benefit the residents by promoting and enhancing law enforcement in our City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is appropriate to accept the donations offered as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Bell as follows:


1. The City Manager, Chief of Police, and the City Attorney are authorized and directed to coordinate with the anonymous donor to facilitate the unconditional gift of three new police vehicles to the City at no cost to the City.
2. When the vehicles are purchased by the donor and the VIN numbers are known to the City, the City Manager shall agendize a resolution for adoption by the City Council to formally accept the gift.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


