

RESOLUTION NO 2016- 21

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A THREE-MONTH CONTRACT EXTENSION WITH THE BELL SERVICE CENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING THE CITY VEHICLE FLEET IN ORDER TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT TIME TO COMPLETE A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP) BIDDING PROCESS.

WHEREAS, the City of Bell currently has a one-year contract with Bell Service Center for fleet maintenance that is scheduled to expire on or about April 22, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bell wants to continue the contract for an additional three-month period to provide sufficient time to complete a Request for Proposal (RFP) process currently being done; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to have a highly qualified company to perform such services until the RFP process is completed; and

WHEREAS, Bell Service Center represents that it is qualified to perform such services and has agreed to do so pursuant to the proposed contract extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a three-month contract extension with the Bell Service Center in a form approved by the City Attorney for the purpose of maintaining the City vehicle fleet in order to provide sufficient time to complete a Request for Proposal (RFP) bidding process.


