A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO APPLY FOR THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS (BSCC) GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$600,000

WHEREAS, the Board of State Community Corrections has opened solicitations for police departments to apply for state grants to reduce recidivism and crime, and to improve community relations;

WHEREAS, the City is interested in applying for this grant to help improve community relationships and decrease the level of crime;

WHEREAS, the City is interested in developing a partnership with the Technology Center to provide programs to our community members and to assist the Police Department in the development of the Police Athletic League (PAL) Center,

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. Authorize the Police Chief to apply for the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) grant in the amount of \$600,000.
