

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-61

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BELL AUTHORIZING A FY 2016-17 BUDGET AMENDMENT TO APPROPRIATE \$140,285 FROM THE UNALLOCATED CDBG BALANCE TO THE TREDER PARK RESTROOM IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Bell passed Resolution No. 2016-03 on January 27, 2016 approving the FY 2016-17 CDBG program and budget allocation in the amount of \$444,811; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bell has received notification from the Los Angeles County Community Development Commission of the availability of previously unspent Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds in the amount of \$140,285; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to allocate the \$140,285 of CDBG funds for the Treder Park Restroom Improvement Project; and


WHEREAS, the City has conducted a public hearing to solicit comments and suggestions from the community for the utilization of these funds.

Section 1. That the City Council approve the amendment to the CDBG program budget to allocate \$140,285 of previously unspent monies for the Treder Park Improvement Project.


