YARD SALE

Permit applications can be obtained at City Hall, Monday-Friday from 8:00am-4:00pm. Permits are issued only once every three months per property. Only the owner and/or tenant can request the permit. Permits are valid only for the upcoming weekend issued (Saturday and Sunday). There are no refunds or rain checks.

Completed yard sale application must be submitted to City Hall. Tenants must provide a property owner's approval signature. Two forms of proof of residency must be provided, such as a government based ID and a utility bill. Permit fee is \$10.

The City of Bell Community Services Department has a strict refund policy. Refunds will **ONLY** be given if program is canceled by the City.

ANIMAL INFORMATION

California law requires that all dogs over the age of four months be vaccinated against rabies and be licensed through the local animal care and control agency. The County of Los Angeles requires the same and that all dogs be spayed/neutered and microchipped. Cats are also required to be vaccinated for rabies at four months of age and be licensed.

Licensing is an important means of identification and can help to return lost pets to their owners quickly. Failure to license your pet may result in fines or penalties.

Purchasing Licenses

Animal licenses may be purchased by completing a license application form and mailing it-along with payment, proof of rabies vaccination and proof of sterilization-to the address on the application. Seniors should include proof of age (i.e. driver's license or identification card) to obtain senior discount. Licenses may also be purchased at the animal care center.

DIAL-A-RIDE

The bus will take registered participants to and from destinations within the City of Bell and is allowed 5 miles outside of the City for general purposes and 8 miles outside the City for medical purposes. METRO

Bus pass will be sold at a first come first serve basis. City of Bell seniors 62 and older, persons with disabilities and students are eligible to purchase their monthly bus passes at the Bell Community Center for a subsidized rate. Bus passes are sold from the 1st to the 15th of the month. Applications may be obtained at the Bell Community Center, however they must be submitted to the Metro offices. Proof of residency is required prior to obtaining a bus pass. Proof of residency consist of I.D. and utility bill with residents name and City of Bell address.

DIAL-A-CAB

Dial-A-Cab is a transportation program available to seniors 60 and older and persons with qualifying disabilities. The taxi will take registered participants to and from destinations within the City of Bell and other approved medical facilities outside of the City. To register simply visit the Bell Community Center with your I.D. and utility bill. If disabled you must bring medical proof of your existing condition. Cost to register is \$5.

LA CAMPANA

La Campana Shuttle is the best way to get around the City and major destinations in the neighboring cities of Cudahy and Bell Gardens. Cost is 50 cents one way. The shuttle operates 6 days per week Monday-Friday 7:00am-7:00pm and Saturday 11:00am-5:00pm. For more information including the schedule simply call (323) 773-1596.
